### WCF Performance Agreement

The International Child Art Foundation (“ICAF”) is producing its 6<sup>th</sup> World Children's Festival (“WCF”) on July 31<sup>st</sup> - August 2<sup>nd</sup> of 2020 at The National Mall across from the Smithsonian Castle. The WCF is a public celebration of *Creativity, Diversity, and Unity*, and its setup at the Mall includes the “World Stage” to showcase students’ talents. ICAF invites [insert name of group] (“Performer”) to participate in the WCF under the following terms and conditions:

- 1) Performer understands and agrees that the WCF is an educational event that celebrates “Creativity, Diversity, and Unity” with scores of performances and educational workshops each day which Performer must attend or participate in during all three days at the time or times when the Performer is not performing. Hence, the presence of the Performer (and its members’) presence is required at the WCF from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm on July 31<sup>st</sup>, August 1<sup>st</sup> and August 2<sup>nd</sup>. If Performer arrives just for its performance and leaves once the performance is over, Performer will not be allowed to perform at the WCF and will be liable for damages under this Agreement.
- 2) Performer understands and agrees that the WCF is produced by ICAF to exclusively promote its mission and the purpose of the WCF as the world’s premier children’s celebration, and hence the Performer agrees that ICAF has a right to film, live cast, and photograph each and all performances, and if Performer films or photographs its own performance or any other performance, these films or photographs are co-owned by ICAF and Performer as shared property. Any public use or broadcast for any purpose whatsoever, including any commercial use, of said shared property must be pre-approved and agree to by ICAF in writing prior to such use or broadcast.
- 3) Performer understands that the WCF is an outdoor event which could be disrupted or delayed if it rains or because of any security reasons by the Park Police.
- 4) Performer agrees to use the handle #WCF2020 for any and all tweets on and about the WCF.
- 5) While ICAF does not charge any performance fee, Performer agrees to pay for own travel, transport, accommodation, food, drinks and snacks during and at the WCF.
- 6) The only WCF ticketed event is the WCF Awards Banquet on August 3<sup>rd</sup> for which Performer can purchase in advance tickets at a discounted price of \$100 per head.
- 7) ICAF will present Performer (its each member) the ‘Exceptional Performance Certificate’ at the WCF Award Banquet. If Performer does not plan to attend the Banquet, the Certificate(s) will be mailed to the Performer in early September 2020.
- 8) Performer must provide ICAF on or before May 15, 2020 a complete list of ALL the equipment Performer will bring to The National Mall so that ICAF can obtain security clearance from the National Park Police.
- 9) Performer must also provide ICAF on or before May 15, 2020 a complete list of ALL the equipment the Performer requests that ICAF arrange, which ICAF will make best efforts to provide but does not guarantee that requested equipment will be available for Performer.
- 10) Performer agrees to abide by any instruction of ICAF staff pertaining to its participation in and performance at the WCF.

- 11) Performer agrees to hold harmless ICAF along with any of its officers, employees or agents, respectively, from all liability, costs, injury and damages that may be incurred by or to any person affiliated with or to any property owned by Performer that may be caused by an activity, condition or event arising out of the performance, preparation for the performance or non-performance or by any and all changes in the performance schedule, including cancellation of the performance or the replacement and substitution of Performer another group by ICAF. This “hold harmless” clause is not intended to indemnify Performer against any liability, costs, damage, insurance, attorney’s fees or related legal and other costs that it may incur as a result of entering into this agreement.
  
- 12) Performer agrees to obtain at its cost the necessary medical insurance and liability insurance for the protection of its equipment and its members, particularly with respect to its child and youth performers.
  
- 13) This Agreement is governed by the laws of the District of Columbia.
